

**Run-A-Mucca Motorcycle Rally  
Regular Meeting  
April 5, 2021**

**Call to Order**

Darrel called the meeting to order at 3:05pm at the Winnemucca Convention Center West Hall.

**Public Comment**

No public was present at this meeting

**Minutes**

The committee had no objections to the minutes of March 18, 2021

**Sponsors**

Jace proposed transforming his Rock 94.3 FM signal into “Run-A-Mucca Radio” to help guide and coordinate as well as promote festival go-ers towards the active events and promotion. He will also be available to announce the main bands of Friday, Saturday and Sunday as well as announce the Poker Run winners on Saturday and the Bike Show winners on Sunday. He requested that in return the committee grant the stage sponsorship to Nomadic Broadcasting and refer to the stage as “Rock 94.3 Run-A-Mucca Main Stage”.

Torey moved to approve the agreement. The motion passed unanimously with Jace and Josh abstaining on the matter.

**Bike Raffle**

Herb and Brian arrived at this time.

**Winnemucca Police Department**

Mike Rangel arrived to address the committee. He notes that he will have enough staff to escort the Memorial Ride on its traditional route. The route has been as follows:

- Depart Winners west lot at 10:30am turning left on Winnemucca Blvd.
- Left turn on Hanson St.
- Left turn on Highland Dr.
- Left turn on East Winnemucca Blvd.

- Right Turn on E Winnemucca Blvd.
- Left Turn on Reinhardt St.
- Left Turn on Hwy 95
- Right Turn at Veterans Memorial Park.

Captain Rangel also reports that they are working on camera towers which would be installed at the venue in order to reduce police presence on the venue.

Brian asked if the Police Department will need rooms during the event.

Mike replied that he may need some but will let us know at a later meeting.

Mike left the meeting at this time.

### **Burning Bike**

As of this writing, Jerry has confirmed that the burning bike is on track to be ready for the event. The bike is a Honda Gold Wing Trike.

Darrel has spoken with Joe Dendary of the Winnemucca Fire Department regarding asking the department to stand by during the Burning Bike. Joe answered that, yes the Fire Department will be on site.

Brian notes that he will make sure the stand is ready.

### **Entertainment**

Nothing new at this time.

### **Events**

The committee skimmed the to-do list and Darrel asked the committee to check their specific duties.

Antoine recommended returning to chorizo and tri-tip for the barbecue at the Paradise Valley Fireman's Park. The committee agreed.

Jace reported that former Chief of Police, Eric Silva, responded to a text that he would be honored to lead the memorial ride on Sunday.

### **Vendors**

Darrel presented a proposed vendor layout. He notes that we have about half of the room with this layout as we have had in the past, but at this moment we have not turned anyone away on the basis of available space. Brian notes that we have some space available still on the proposed layout and will make other space available as needed.

No criticisms were made of the proposed layout.

Brian reports that he will make sure there is power available for the vendors and bands on the venue.

Darrel commented that Road Rider of Reno had proposed bringing a small bike shop for minor repairs as well as the apparel they brought last year. He notes that with Sonoma Cycle in town, he asked that they not perform minor repairs.

The committee proposed that since Sonoma Cycle has not been involved in Run-A-Mucca for a few years that we should allow Road Rider to perform minor repairs at the event.

Darrel spoke with Jason, who noted that he has no objections, provided they have all the standard permits and licenses.

Darrel has sent a message to Road Rider of Reno to ask if they are still interested in bringing their shop for tire and minor repairs.

### **Covid 19**

The committee asked that a Covid 19 statement be added to the website letting customers know that local businesses are still mandated to require masks and social distancing inside their businesses.

Darrel has added the following statement to the runamucca.com landing page:

**Covid 19 updates**

All participants and spectators at this year's Run-A-Mucca Motorcycle & Music Festival are reminded to wear masks and socially distance per local guidelines.

Those with COVID-like symptoms or who have recently been exposed to someone with active COVID-19 should stay home.

As of April 12, 2021 all local businesses are must require masks to be worn inside.

**T-Shirts**

Darrel has added the T-Shirt design to the website.

**Volunteers**

The committee notes that we are short of volunteers needed to accomplish added activities.

Members suggest adding event related perks such as exclusive meet and greets and encouraging volunteers to represent their local organizations
